

Please take notice that Riverhead Police Department intends to submit a grant application for “Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program” funding in the amount of \$71,934.

If approved, equipment will be purchased in the following four areas:

- 1) Bay Constable Boat—The Town of Riverhead recently replaced a 20 year old vessel that is used to patrol the town’s waterways, enforce marine laws and response to rescue situations. The requested equipment is necessary to get this boat into immediate service.

The amount requested for this purpose is **\$36,670.**

- 2) Computer Aided Dispatch and Record Management System—The Riverhead Police Department is in need of a new computer server to replace the existing server that was purchased in 2004 and is nearing capacity. The department has been advised by its system vendor that a new server is needed in order to upgrade the current system and add an alarm billing program.

The amount requested for this purpose is **\$11,669.**

- 3) New Vehicle Computer Systems—The Riverhead Police Department would like to purchase vehicle computer systems for its marked sector cars. These computers would enable the department to get the computer aided dispatch information in the vehicles, as well as the ability to issue computerized summonses and accident reports using the New York State TrACS system. The grant would fund three such systems at \$7,845.47 each.

The amount requested for this purpose is **\$23,536.41.**

- 4) Portable Radios—The Town will purchase three portable radios for the uniformed patrol division. The cost of each radio is about \$2,019.53.

The amount requested for this purpose is **\$6,058.59**
