HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE (NON-RECYCLABLE)



Up to four (4) bags, bundles or containers of non-recyclable garbage per single-family dwelling shall be collected. Garbage must be secured from animals in strong, sealed bags in tight-fitting containers. For small homeowner repair/improvement debris and large auto parts, please contact the carter listed to make arrangements for disposal.

RECYCLABLES



Please refer to your RECYCLING PICKUP SCHEDULE for the appropriate week. Paper recycling pickup—Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, white-page telephone books and junk mail are to be bundled together or placed in paper bags and brought curbside for pickup. Corrugated and non-corrugated cardboard products must be in BUNDLES TIED WITH TWINE OR PAPER BAGS.

ALTERNATE WEEK: Co-mingled Recycling Pickup—Plastics, glass, tin and aluminum may be co-mingled with each other in containers and placed curbside for pickup. If using can other than blue recycle pail, leave lid off so carter may see what is in pail.

DO NOT PACKAGE ANY OF THE ABOVE MATERIALS IN PLASTIC BAGS

YARD WASTE & BULK ITEMS



Up to TWELVE (12) BAGS, BUNDLES OR CONTAINERS of leaves and other compostable items (EXCLUDING GRASS CLIPPINGS) shall be collected. Branches shall be bundled and **should not exceed four (4) feet in length.** In addition up to six (6) bulk items (i.e. appliances, scrap metal, furniture, mattresses, rugs) shall be collected. All bulk items must be in safe condition and put curbside for pickup.

(NOTE: BULK ITEMS ARE LARGE ITEMS AND NOT LARGE AMOUNTS OF TRASH. ANYTHING THAT CAN BE PUT INTO A CONTAINER OR GARBAGE BAG SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF AS HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.)

RESIDENTS OBLIGATIONS

All residents receiving service shall place all solid wastes immediately adjacent to the roadway in front of residences at curbside **BEFORE 6:00 A.M.** on scheduled collection days. Residents shall keep the lifting weight of containers, bags and bundles to **BELOW FIFTY (50) POUNDS EACH.** **PLEASE CONTACT THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF MEDICAL SHARPS.**

PLEASE NOTE THE HOLIDAYS FOR 2009 ON THE RECYCLING PICK-UP SCHEDULE (AS INDICATED BY A RED CIRCLE)

Collection services are cancelled on these holidays. When collection is cancelled, the remaining collection schedule for the week will be one (1) day later, which shall include Saturday. **(NOTE: Collection may also be cancelled due to snow or severe weather conditions. In such instances, residents should monitor WRIV 1390 AM or WLNG 92.1 FM for news or postponements/cancellations due to weather conditions.)**

Special arrangements for handicapped individuals can be made by calling the carter listed. Chemical (S.T.O.P.) collection days will be posted in local newspapers.
