Projects pending:

Atlantis Marine World: To clarify the Commission's previously stated comments on the Atlantis Marine World Phases 2 & 3 project, the Commission unanimously approved a resolution recommending that the Town Board approve the site plan updated February 13, 2009.

Suffolk County Historical Society: The Commission informally reviewed and commented upon proposed signage for three façades of the building.

Landmark nominations:

Reeves Park Flag Pole and Old Pump: The commission has received a note from the Supervisor's office regarding a request that the LPC consider this as a landmark. Members were asked to stop by the site, obtain photos and determine ownership.

Watch list Richard reported that the Northville school might be in contract.

Historic district guidelines: The guidelines are posted on the town's web site. However, they are difficult to use and difficult to find. Richard will communicate with Chris Kempner to remedy.

Web site: The LPC information on the town's web site is in two locations, with different information. Richard will attempt to have this remedied and corrected.

Downtown National Register District: Next steps will be to prepare a map and meet with the Town Board, probably after the November election.
