That I am familiar with Section 605.15.3 of the Plumbing Code of New York State known as the New York State Building Code.

“Solder joints shall be made in accordance with the methods of ASTM B 828. All cut tube ends shall be reamed to the full inside diameter of the tube end. All joint surfaces shall be cleaned. A flux conforming to ASTM B 813 shall be applied. The joint shall be soldered with a solder conforming to ASTM B 32. The joining of water supply piping shall be made with lead-free solder and fluxes. Lead free "shall mean a chemical composition equal to or less than 0.2-percent lead.”

And Section 604 of the Plumbing Code of New York State, known as the New York State Building Code

Anti-scald and /or thermal shock preventing devices shall be installed in the water supply to individual bathing and /or showering fixtures to provide a reasonably safe degree of control from excessively high water temperatures. The device shall be of pressure balancing, thermostat mixing or combination pressure balancing/thermostatic types.”

Let it be known that the Town of Riverhead has relied on this statement in the issuance of all permits and Certificates of Occupancy.
